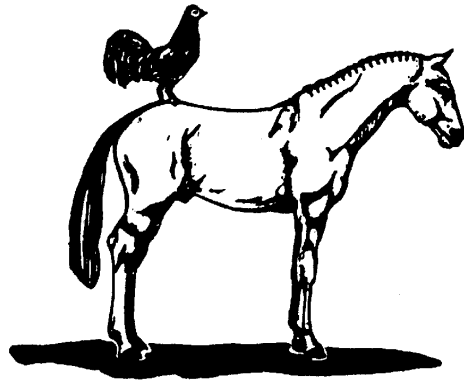

CLASS #	CLASS DESCRIPTION	CLASS #
1	<u>Equitation - Walk Only.</u> <u>Must</u> be accompanied by a leader and may have up to three aides. May be asked to halt and circle (10 meter diameter), change direction by half-circle, and serpentine through cones or figure 8.	11
2	<u>Equitation - Walk/Trot.</u> <u>Must</u> be accompanied by at least one aide. Will be asked to perform at the walk as in Class 1 and at the sitting trot for a short distance.	12
3	<u>Independent Equitation - Walk/Trot.</u> No aides. Riders will be judged on hands, seat and control of mount. May be asked to trot a figure 8 or perform other independent tests for the judge. May be asked to trot posting and sitting. Diagonals not to count.	13
4	<u>Trail Class - Walk Only.</u> May have aide(s). Must have a leader.	14
5	<u>Trail Class - Walk.</u> With an aide, <u>no</u> leader.	15
6	<u>Trail Class - Walk/Trot.</u> May have aide(s), <u>no</u> leader.	16
7	<u>Dressage Test Aspire - Walk #1.</u> May have aide(s), <u>no</u> leader.	17
8	<u>Dressage Test Aspire - Walk #2.</u> May have aide(s), <u>no</u> leader.	18
9	<u>Dressage Test Aspire - Walk/Trot #1.</u> May have aide(s), no leader.	19
10	<u>Dressage Test Aspire - Walk/Trot #2.</u> No aides, no leader.	20

DIVISION C – Open Classes; No aides.

CLASS #	CLASS DESCRIPTION
22	Advanced Equitation - Walk Only - Independent. Riders will be judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Riders may be asked to circle, change direction by a half-circle or perform a figure 8.
23	Advanced Equitation - Walk/Trot - Independent. Riders will be judged on hands, seat and control of mount. They will be asked to perform sitting trot and posting trot unless physically unable to. Riders may be asked to circle, change direction by a half-circle or perform a figure 8 at the trot.
24	Advanced Equitation - Walk/Trot/Canter (as above).
25	Advanced Trail - Walk Only.
26	Advanced Trail Class - Walk/Trot.
27	<u>Dressage Test Aspire - Walk #3.</u>
28	<u>Dressage Test Aspire - Walk/Trot #3.</u>
29	<u>Dressage Test - 2007 UASEq Training Level #1.</u>

ASPIRE tests will be used; they are available upon request.

DIVISION D – Open to all Riders.

30	Costume Class - Open to all competitors.
31	Lead Line - Open to those not entered in any classes other than costume.

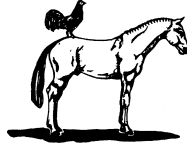

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Riders may enter one equitation, one trail and one dressage class in Division A, B or C.**
There is no cross-entering between Divisions A, B, or C. Entry fees are \$10.00 per class, payable to Thorncroft. Important note- all entries and fees must be postmarked by September 4th. **Entries postmarked and received after that date are subject to a \$20.00 late fee**
2. Classes are open to riders of all ages. If entries warrant, classes will be divided by age (to the best of our ability). Please give age when entering.
3. The horse show committee reserves the right to combine, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
4. Riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets and hard-soled shoes with a heel, boots with a heel or Devonshire boots whenever mounted.
5. Entries close on September 4th. A copy of a negative Coggins test, taken within the last twelve months, must accompany the entry form.
6. No class will be delayed if riders are not ready. Contact the show secretary **immediately** if there is a time conflict in your schedule. Times will be mailed to programs approximately one week before the show.
7. The horse show committee reserves the right to stop any activity they feel jeopardizes the rider's safety and/or the well being of any horse.
8. Leaders and side-aides are reminded that their position is one of safety - unnecessary assistance will be penalized by the judges.
9. No Thorncroft horses will be lent to outside riders.
10. Safety stirrups are required for all saddles.
11. Adaptive equipment is permitted so long as a rider is not attached or tied to the saddle or horse in any manner. No side or draw reins.
